Attendance & Punctuality



If the weather is cold, pupils can wear their school jumpers or their PE fleece over the top of their t-shirts.

Morning nursery are to join us on the field at 1.50pm for a prompt start. Reception children are to come into school in their PE kit and Nursery children to come in sports clothes (trainers are preferred). Parents of pupils in Nursery and Reception are welcome to join us in the EYFS garden for afternoon tea, after Sports Day.
