




I work and learn best when:

Follow up and repair

Reminder

This might happen if we are talking whilst others are talking, swinging on chairs, calling out, improper use of equipment, disturbing learning, distracting others etc. An adult will remind us of what is expected.

Warning

This might happen if we continue to behave in a way which disrupts or does not fit with the St Stephen's Way.

Follow up

This will happen if we have not responded to warnings. We will have reflection time to think about how our behaviour has affected our learning and those around us. I might lose privileges such as representing the school in sport. Our teacher will inform Mr Fallon, Mrs Long and our parents.

Follow up and repair

This will happen if we have not responded to warnings and follow up (or have acted in an extremely inappropriate way such as fighting, using hurtful language, damaging property) We will learn away from our class and have time to think about how we have harmed others. Our parents will have a meeting with our teacher, Mr Fallon and Mrs Long and a plan will be made to help us fix and improve our behaviour.

What happens when it goes well?

I'll be told and praised

Adults will tell me when I'm doing good things and my efforts are being noticed. I will also be praised when I'm acting in line with St Stephen's Way, and making a positive contribution to the life of the school. I might even get a mission and vision sticker

Recognition boards

If I keep doing good things, or my group or class keep doing good things, it will be noted on our class recognition board as a reminder to others and to people coming into our classroom. We will also be given a mission and vision sticker.

A message home

If I keep doing good things, or my group or class keep doing good things, I will receive a message to take home on a celebration card, to tell my parents how pleased my teachers are with my efforts.

Golden Time

If I continuously behave well, always trying hard in my work and play, I will be rewarded with some free time to choose an activity I enjoy.

Awards certificates

If my efforts and contribution to my learning and life of the school is consistent, I will receive a certificate at an assembly where my parents will be invited to attend and celebrate.

Where the word of God, and the service and strength of St Stephen, guides our steps and leads us in learning.
