

## **Uniform Guidance:**

Children of St. Stephen's School are required to wear uniform.

School uniform:

Red jumper, blue polo shirt, grey skirt or trousers and practical black school shoes – no trainers, no leggings.

For the summer months – girls can wear a red and white school dress and boys are permitted to wear grey shorts.

Children require indoor and outdoor PE kit: Red school t-shirt, black shorts and trainers/plimsolls with Velcro or lace fasteners.

Outdoor PE kit:

Black tracksuit bottoms (not leggings for the colder months) Pupils can purchase red school sports fleeces from the office for P.E. and school trips. Pupils can wear black football socks to support shin pad use, for football lessons/after-school clubs.

Jewellery (excluding watches) must not be worn to school - this includes earrings. We specifically request that children do not get their ears pierced during the school year. Any child who has had their ears pierced and is unable to remove them because of the 6-week healing process must use a plaster to cover their studs during P.E. lessons. Plasters should be provided by parents. Should a child require any form of assistance with earrings, school will contact parents, requesting that they come in and provide it. In the event of any accident, which involves the wearing of earrings, the school will not be held responsible in any way.

All clothing must be clearly labelled with the child's name. Ideally, P.E. kit will be brought into school on a Monday, and taken home for washing on a Friday.

The school does not permit children to have 'extreme' haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. Hairstyles and haircuts, which are deemed too extreme, such as: tramlines, stars, shaved heads, extreme patterns 'V' styles, Mohican cuts, or dyed, tipped or dipped hair are also forbidden.

For girls, hair accessories should be simple and should not detract from the uniform. Large hairbands/multicoloured ribbons are not permitted.

All items of clothing – including clothes and wellingtons – should be clearly marked with the child's name.
