After School Club

It is great to see that after school club is becoming more popular, meaning that we are supporting a lot of parents with childcare after school. Pupils can be collected from after school club up to 5.20pm for a charge of £6.00 per day. We are not covered beyond this, and it is not acceptable to collect children later than 5.20pm.
